1 Locate the word in question in the text. Read the sentences near the word to get some hints.
2 Underline the keywords in each option.
3 Replace the word in the text with each option and see which option matches the context best.

Ceam-moreb
Sometimes you can also get the meaning of the words from their roots, prefixes and suffixes.

The root of a word is its most basic form. We add a prefix to the beginning of a word and a suffix to the end of a word to form new words that have different meanings.
eag The root of the word 'acting' is 'act'.
eage The prefix 'un-' in the word 'unhappy' means 'not'.
egs The suffix '-less' in the word 'hopeless' means 'without'.
